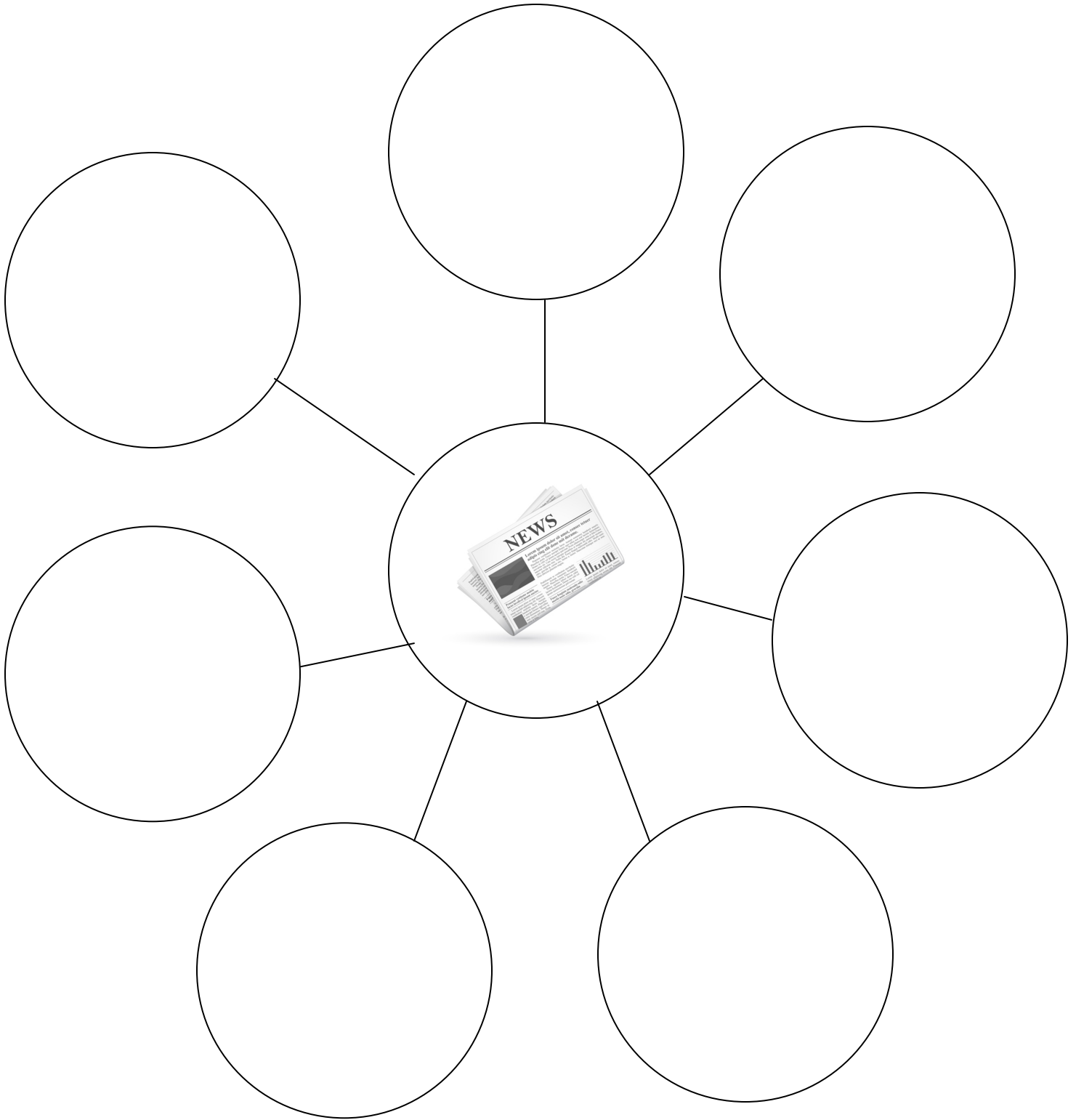


What's "new" in the world?
